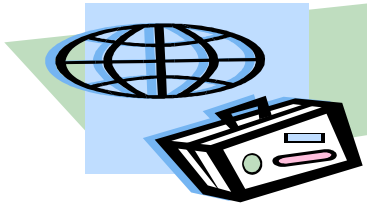

A non-refundable deposit of \$20 for a semi-private room or \$30 for a private room will reserve your place. Final payment is due January 15, 2020. Scholarships are available.

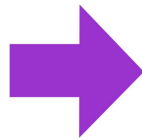
